Pursuant to Section 18.1(2) of the *Qulliq Energy Corporation Act*, Qulliq Energy Corporation (QEC) requires ministerial approval in advance of undertaking a major capital project that has a total cost that exceeds \$5 million. Please find attached a major project permit application to construct a new head office building in Baker Lake for your review and consideration.
