Reporting to the President and CEO, you will lead the Operations Department in the maintenance and operation of all power plants within Nunavut. Your principal objective as Director of Operations will centre on identifying and driving continuous improvement throughout QEC's operations, from generation to delivery and through to maintenance, to maximize the effectiveness, efficiency and reliability of electrical service to the people of Nunavut. The development and execution of Operations initiatives will be instrumental in achieving the key corporate objectives of transparency and accountability while ensuring alignment with power quality expectations and standards within the North American electricity industry.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

- Driving standards of excellence in electricity generation and distribution to all Nunavut communities;
- Providing leadership in creating a safety-first culture while keeping performance front and centre;
- Overseeing compliance with all environmental regulations and requirements;
- Maximizing use of SCADA to enhance materials and systems maintenance and support decision-making;
- Supporting Capital Planning and Procurement aligned with QEC's business strategy;
- Acting as corporate liaison with public authorities, officials and agencies, industry representatives and community leaders, and in a consultative role to the CEO, Senior Management Committee, the Board of Directors, and Government officials;
- Partnering in the research, development and execution of proactive, progressive plant maintenance programs and leading the upgrade of electrical generation and distribution infrastructure;
- Setting targets for environmental performance and integrating environmental protection measures into QEC's business operation and corporate goals and objectives; and
- Leveraging internal expertise and providing training and coaching to meet current and future needs.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS INCLUDE:

- A university degree (preferred) with an Engineering, Energy Management, Utilities Management, Business Management or similar focus, OR a 3-year Electrical Technologist diploma;
- An MBA or a professional designation in a relevant field (an asset);
- 7 to 10 years' progressive, extensive operations experience within a utilities environment;
- 5 years' experience at the management or senior level;
- Experience working with a Board of Directors, senior managers, internal and external stakeholders, and subordinates;
- Experience in initiating business proposals, preparing business cases, and producing cost justifications, budgeting, forecasting and capital planning projects;
- Comprehensive understanding of diesel-generating facilities and maintenance procedures;
- · Project scheduling and workforce planning experience;
- Knowledge of Management Information Systems (i.e., ERP, SCADA) and their applications;
- Knowledge of Nunavut, the land, language and culture (an asset); and
- The ability to speak Inuktitut, Inuinnagtun and/or French (an asset).
